Pursuant to this Court's order of June 21, 2007, the Government has submitted to the Court the guidelines recently adopted by defendants-appellants United States Agency for International Development ("USAID") and United States Department of Health and Human Services ("HHS") relating to the policy requirement in 22 U.S.C. § 7631(f). The Government has further informed this Court that both guidelines are currently in effect. It is therefore ORDERED that the parties are to submit letter briefs, no more than 20 pages in length, addressing the impact of these guidelines on the constitutional and statutory challenges currently pending before this Court. The parties are to simultaneously file opening briefs by August 23, 2007, and response briefs by September 6, 2007.
